Our **vision** is for local churches to take the primary responsibility for the **mentoring** and **mobilization** of its members, resulting in a healthy local church, capable of **multiplication** through the sending out of **servant leaders** to launch **new churches**.

SERVANT LEADERS PARTNERSHIPS

Servant Leaders Exists to partner with the local church to Mentor, Mobilize and Multiply its ministry and leadership potential. We do this through three types of partnerships.

Church To Church Great Commission Partnerships. These partnerships consist of two churches coming together for the purpose of fulfilling the Great Commission together. This happens through sharing of resources and personnel to encourage and mobilize the church. We have successfully created partnerships between churches in the US with churches in Latin America, churches in South America with churches in Central America as well as church to church partnerships within the USA.

1. Resource Partnerships

The Resource Partnership exists to support local churches with the materials, courses and seminars that Servant Leaders has made available for ministry and leadership training. We make these materials available at no charge through our three websites in English, Spanish and Portuguese.

2. Mobilization Partnerships

The Mobilization Partnership exists to equip local churches through onsite and web based mentoring and training. The goal is to assist the church in unleashing men and women into ministry and leadership within their church. Upon fulfilling this objective the church can move forward in accomplishing the following three goals:

- a. To strengthen the existing church
- b. To plant new local churches
- c. To send out missionaries.

3. Pioneer Partnerships

The Pioneer Partnership provides an on site Servant Leaders Missionary to work along side local church leadership in order to assist them in successfully reproducing themselves in the form of a new local church plant.

Dan & Eirana's Ministry Accountability

- 1. Sending Church: The Local Church is the New Testament authority over all ministry. The Doyle family acts under the authority of Gage Chapel Community Church as an extension of their ministry.
- 2. Servant Leaders Tactical Team: A leadership team of 5 partnership local church pastors and missionaries provide oversight to Servant Leaders and the Doyle family. This team meets at different levels weekly to oversee operational and strategic decisions that occur on a day to day basis.
- 3. Servant Leaders Strategic Team: A leadership team of partnering churches and missionaries provide oversight to the mission of Servant Leaders. They help to provide accountability to the Doyle family as well as overall Servant Leaders Ministries leadership of areas such as finance and direction. This team meets twice a year.
- 4. Partnering Churches: The Doyle family is responsible to continually report to their partnering churches. Partnering church pastors will be given a strategic plan that will be both measurable and practical for each year.
