We saw people get excited about giving, serving, and going! We committed to raise \$500 to help with VBS in Chillanes this Summer. Through the Ecuador church's hard work and generosity, \$720 was raised! Praise the Lord!

We started Ethos Missions Academy with SLI back in 2019. The first opportunity was in Germany. In 2021, we hosted EMA in Ecuador. July 2023 will be the third time in Costa Rica. This is an opportunity for a first-hand look at what missions, church planting, and discipleship looks like in a Post-Christian/Post-Modern society in the context and culture of another country. This has been a great introduction to missions for those considering God's leading.
