The idea is to raise up families for launching the next church plant in 2022. God is already opening so many doors and allowing us to connect with families that we've identified to work with and see raised up for ministry.



Pray for the summer as we host four different teams from the States to partner with La Fe in the work here. We are going to have Orchard Community Church-Rochester, NY July 3-12. Pray that God would work in people's hearts during this time as we develop the church property and join in outreaches in neighborhood parks. This will be a great effort between OCC and La Fe!
