To a large degree, we will continue doing the same (training national churches, coaching church planters/pastors, pastoring the pastor, etc.), but be based in the U.S.

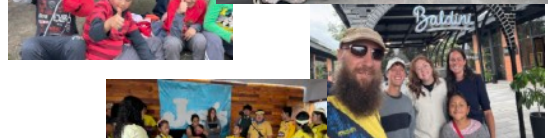
